

DIRECTIONS to Hunt Test Site:

ROUTE TO HUNTING TEST SITE *From Milwaukee or Madison:* I-94 to Highway 67 (Oconomowoc, WI). Go South on Highway 67 passing Highway 18 and County Road C. The grounds are on the left (east), just past County Road C. Look for signs. ***From Chicago area:*** Go northwest on Highway 12 (Rand Road) through Elkhorn, WI. Continue onto Highways 12/67, then Highway 67, north through Eagle, WI. The grounds are on the right (east), just before County Road C. Look for signs. **GPS Coordinates: N 42° 57.091' Q088° 28.520' . Address W367S5302 Hwy 67**

*****PARKING STICKER REQUIREMENTS** A Wisconsin State Park/Forest vehicle sticker is required to use the Ottawa Field Trial Grounds. Stickers can be purchased at the Forest Headquarters on Highway 59 west of Eagle, or via the yellow self registration box located near the entrance on the day of the Hunting Test. ***Vehicles without stickers will be ticketed by the DNR!***



TEST SITE: Water is available at the site. Food and soft drinks will be available for sale. A shelter is located on the grounds. Overnight camping is allowed, a permit is required. There are no public phones available on the grounds but a cell phone will be available for emergency use

Prizes: All Qualifying Dogs will receive AKC approved ribbons.

Judges: Judges' decisions are final. Once the dog comes to the line, the judge has complete control over dogs and handlers. Judges shall have the authority to disqualify a dog that is not present within five (5) minutes after it has been called to run by the judges. A person may not agree with a judge's decision, but they cannot confront the Judge, other than to politely ask why the dog did not qualify. Any rudeness on the part of the handler is subject to disciplinary action. Judges are not obligated to discuss scores with handlers, but if they elect to do so, such discussions shall be held only after completion of the test. A handler can lodge a complaint with the Hunting Test Committee but they shall not confront the judge. The Hunting Test Committee will take action regarding such situations at the conclusion of the stake.

Refund Policy:

No entry fees will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a judge, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee. Entry fee for a dog that is injured, ill or deceased after the closing date will be refunded (less \$10 administrative fee per day) if a veterinarian's certificate is presented to the Test Secretary 30 minutes prior to the start of judging.

A BREAK ACTION: (S x S, O/U, Single Shot) shotgun must be carried by Master Test Handlers. (No pump action, bolt action, or semi-automatic shotguns.) BLANK PISTOL: Must be carried by all handlers in all test levels. Handlers are responsible for having their own blank gun.
